Overview of Positions

Director: Directors will be in charge developing a vision for the show associated with the camp or workshop as well as executing that vision successfully with the help of his/her creative team, which will include a music director, choreographer, intern, and the studio's Artistic Director. The director will lead his/her team in auditioning, casting, preparing a rehearsal schedule, overseeing all rehearsals, planning out costumes, sets, and props, communicating with parents, staying within the set budget, and must be present at all performances. The director is essentially in charge of the show and its outcome.

Music Director: Music directors will be in charge of teaching the music of the show to the cast members. He/she will help the director cast the show, assign any solos/duets/small groups that may have not been specified in the script, create a music rehearsal schedule, be present for all rehearsals, and be present on all show nights to perform vocal warm-ups with the cast and help backstage.

Choreographer: Choreographers will plan and teach original choreography to the cast. He/she will help the director cast the show, create a choreography schedule, teach any and all songs the director specifies should include choreography, be present at all rehearsals and performances.

Intern: Interns will serve as an assistant to the director as well as stage manager for the show. He/she will be responsible for making any copies (script or cd's), running tech for rehearsals until actual tech crew is called, keep watch over the cast as a whole, being in charge of the cast during breaks, taking blocking and choreography notes, preparing the prop table and other technical duties as the show approaches opening night, must be present at all performances, call time, and remain backstage with the cast for all shows.

Youth Volunteer: Youth Volunteer's main job is to aide and assist the younger cast members throughout the camp. They will be expected help with tasks such as bathroom/lunch/and snack breaks, assisting the intern with backstage needs during rehearsals and performances, and help younger members take notes in their scripts. Youth volunteers will be expected to be at every rehearsal and performance.
